

Food contact statement for adhesive S4000N

Avery Dennison adhesive S4000N has been tested by a certified laboratory and has received a certificate of compliance.

S4000N complies with European food regulation 1935/2004/EC, with the German Recommendation (BfR) XIV and FDA § 175.105. It also meets the demands of the limit values laid down in 10/2011/EU.

In accordance with the requirements of relevant EU food regulations, the adhesive S4000N may safely stand in direct contact with dry and moist, non-fatty foodstuffs. Moreover, the adhesive layer may stand in direct contact with such kind of fatty foodstuffs to which a reduction factor of at least 3 according to the 10/2011/EU can be applied, as far as the ratio of the contact surface of the label regarded to the total weight of the foodstuff does not exceed 3 dm²/kg. This is based on migration results from testing in olive oil as simulant. Furthermore, the seams (edges) of the label material may safely come into direct contact with all kinds of foodstuffs.

According to FDA regulations, the adhesive may come into direct contact with dry foodstuffs, or alternatively it must be separated from the foodstuffs by a functional barrier.
